House Concurrent Resolution
A concurrent resolution authorizing use of the
Chamber of the House of Representatives on
December 4, 2001, for an assembly commemorating
the National Day of Reconciliation.

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has authorized the use of the United States Capitol Rotunda for an assembly commemorating a National Day of Reconciliation, and the State of Florida wishes to join in this observation, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida, the Senate Concurring:

That the Chamber of the House of Representatives of the State of Florida is authorized to be used at any time on December 4, 2001, for an assembly commemorating the National Day of Reconciliation. On that day, the House of Representatives and the Senate of the State of Florida shall assemble in the Chamber with the Chaplain of the House of Representatives and the Chaplain of the Senate in attendance. During this assembly, the Members of the House of Representatives and the Senate may gather to humbly seek the blessings of Providence for forgiveness, reconciliation, unity, and charity for all people of the United States, thereby assisting the Nation to realize its potential as the champion of hope, the vindicator of the defenseless, and the guardian of freedom.
