(1)(a) To help mitigate the impact of the 12 midyear reduction in the 2001-2002 fiscal year appropriation 13 for the Florida Education Finance Program, each district school board is authorized to expend in its operating budget 14 15 as nonrecurring funds up to 0.5 mills of its nonvoted capital 16 improvement millage levied pursuant to s. 236.25(2), Florida 17 Statutes, for the 2001-2002 fiscal year, that will produce an amount not to exceed \$125 per full-time equivalent student. 18 19 This authorized use of proceeds from this millage levy is in 20 addition to the authorized uses set forth in s. 236.25, 21 Florida Statutes, and is for the 2001-2002 fiscal year only. 2.2 Any proceeds from this millage levy used to replace the midyear budget reduction in the Florida Education Finance 23 24 Program shall be transferred by budget amendment approved by 25 the district school board at a regular meeting of the school 26 board. 27 (b) If the proceeds from 0.5 mills produce less than 28 \$125 per full-time equivalent student in any school district, 29 the additional amount required to equal \$125 per full-time equivalent student shall be provided from state funds. 30 31

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If a district school board has not levied (C) sufficient millage pursuant to s. 236.25(2), Florida Statutes, for the 2001-2002 fiscal year to produce \$125 per full-time equivalent student and the school board has other similar funds available, the school board may use such funds in lieu б of proceeds from millage. (2) This section is repealed effective June 30, 2002. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. HOUSE SUMMARY Authorizes equalized nonvoted capital improvement millage to be expended for district school board operations in fiscal year 2001-2002. Provides for the use of state funds or other funds under certain circumstances. Provides for repeal.

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
