A bill to be entitled

An act relating to pharmacy; amending s.
465.009, F.S.; allowing continuing professional
pharmaceutical education requirements to be met
at any time during the biennium preceding
application for license renewal by eliminating
the requirement that a specified number of
hours of the biennial requirements be done each
year; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 465.009, Florida
Statutes, is amended to read:

465.009 Continuing professional pharmaceutical
education.--

(1) No license renewal shall be issued by the
department until the licensee submits proof satisfactory to
the board that during the 2 years prior to her or his
application for renewal the licensee has participated in not
less than 30 ~~15~~ hours ~~per year~~ of continuing professional
pharmaceutical education in courses approved by the board.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.
