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A bill to be entitled

An act relating to bonds and liens; amending s. 210.08, F.S.; providing methods other than a bond for dealers, agents, or distributing agents to guarantee tax payment to the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation; amending s. 713.135, F.S.; revising a provision of the Construction Lien Law to increase a threshold amount requiring filing of a notice of commencement; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 210.08, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

210.08 Bond for payment of taxes.--Each dealer, agent, or distributing agent shall file with the division a surety bond, certificate of deposit, or irrevocable letter of credit acceptable to the division in the sum of \$10,000 as surety for the payment of all taxes; provided, however, that where in the discretion of the division the amount of business done by the dealer, agent, or distributing agent is of such volume that a bond of less than \$10,000 will be adequate to secure the payment of all taxes assessed as authorized by the cigarette tax law, the division may accept a bond, certificate of deposit, line of credit, or letter of credit in a lesser sum than \$10,000, but in no event shall it accept a bond, certificate of deposit, or letter of credit of less than \$1,000, and it may at any time in its discretion require any

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bond, certificate of deposit, or letter of credit in an amount less than \$10,000 to be increased not to exceed \$10,000.

Section 2. Paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of section 713.135, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

713.135 Notice of commencement and applicability of lien.--

- When any person applies for a building permit, the authority issuing such permit shall:
- (d) Furnish to the applicant two or more copies of a form of notice of commencement conforming with s. 713.13. the direct contract is greater than\$5,000\$2,500, the applicant shall file with the issuing authority prior to the first inspection either a certified copy of the recorded notice of commencement or a notarized statement that the notice of commencement has been filed for recording, along with a copy thereof. In the absence of the filing of a certified copy of the recorded notice of commencement, the issuing authority shall not perform or approve subsequent inspections until the applicant files by mail, facsimile, hand delivery, or any other means such certified copy with the issuing authority. The certified copy of the notice of commencement must contain the name and address of the owner, the name and address of the contractor, and the location or address of the property being improved. The issuing authority shall verify that the name and address of the owner, the name of the contractor, and the location or address of the property being improved which is contained in the certified copy of the notice of commencement is consistent with the information in the building permit application. The issuing authority shall provide the recording information on the certified copy of the 31 recorded notice of commencement to any person upon request.

This subsection does not require the recording of a notice of commencement prior to the issuance of a building permit. If a local government requires a separate permit or inspection for installation of temporary electrical service or other temporary utility service, land clearing, or other preliminary site work, such permits may be issued and such inspections may be conducted without providing the issuing authority with a certified copy of a recorded notice of commencement or a notarized statement regarding a recorded notice of commencement. This subsection does not apply to a direct contract to repair or replace an existing heating or air-conditioning system in an amount less than \$5,000.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

HOUSE SUMMARY

Provides for a certificate of deposit or an irrevocable letter of credit as an alterative to a bond for taxes required by a dealer, agent, or distributing agent to be furnished to the Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation. Revises a provision of the Construction Lien Law to increase a threshold amount requiring the filing of a notice of commencement.
