**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 43, between lines 14 and 15,

insert:

Section 8. The Office of Legislative Services shall contract for a business case study of the feasibility of outsourcing the administrative, investigative, legal, and prosecutorial functions and other tasks and services that are necessary to carry out the regulatory responsibilities of the Board of Dentistry, employing its own executive director and other staff, and obtaining authority over collections and expenditures of funds paid by professions regulated by the board into the Medical Quality Assurance Trust Fund. This feasibility study must include a business plan and an assessment of the direct and indirect costs associated with outsourcing these functions. The sum of \$50,000 is appropriated from the Board of Dentistry account within the Medical Quality Assurance Trust Fund to the Office of Legislative Services for the purpose of contracting for the
