Wildflower Council; creation; functions .--17 (1) There is created within the Florida Wildflower Foundation, Inc., the Wildflower Council, consisting of a 18 19 maximum of 11 members, to direct and oversee the expenditure of the Wildflower Account established pursuant to section 20 21 320.08058(28), Florida Statutes. The Wildflower Council shall include a representative from the University of Florida 2.2 Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences, the Department of 23 Transportation, the Department of Environmental Protection, 24 25 the Florida League of Cities, and the Florida Association of 26 Counties. Other members of the council may include 27 representatives from the Florida Federation of Garden Clubs, 28 Inc., the Think Beauty Foundation, the Florida chapter of the 29 American Society of Landscape Architects, Inc., the Master 30 Gardener's Program, and two members of the Florida Wildflower Foundation, Inc. 31

The Wildflower Council shall develop procedures of 1 (2) 2 operation, research contracts, educational programs, and 3 wildflower planting grants for Florida native wildflowers, plants, and grasses. The council shall also make the final 4 5 determination as to what constitutes acceptable species of 6 wildflowers and other plantings supported by these programs. 7 Section 2. Subsection (28) of section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 8 320.08058 Specialty license plates.--9 (28) FLORIDA WILDFLOWER LICENSE PLATES.--10 11 (a) The department shall develop a Florida Wildflower 12 license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida" 13 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "State 14 Wildflower" and "coreopsis" must appear at the bottom of the 15 plate. The annual use fees shall be distributed to the 16 (b) Wildflower Account established by the Florida Wildflower 17 Foundation, Inc. Keep Florida Beautiful, Inc., created by s. 18 403.4131. The proceeds must be used to establish native 19 20 Florida wildflower research programs, wildflower educational 21 programs, and wildflower grant programs to municipal, county, 22 and community-based groups in this state. A maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds from the sale of such plates may be 23 24 used for administrative costs. Section 3. Subsection (10) of section 403.4131, 25 26 Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 27 403.4131 "Keep Florida Beautiful, Incorporated"; 28 placement of signs .--29 (10)(a) There is created within Keep Florida 30 Beautiful, Inc., the Wildflower Advisory Council, consisting of a maximum of nine members to direct and oversee the 31 2

expenditure of the Wildflower Account. The Wildflower Advisory 1 2 Council shall include a representative from the University of 3 Florida Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences, the Florida Department of Transportation, and the Florida 4 5 Department of Environmental Protection, the Florida League of Cities, and the Florida Association of Counties. Other members 6 7 of the committee may include representatives from the Florida 8 Federation of Garden Clubs, Inc., Think Beauty Foundation, the Florida Chapter of the American Society of Landscape 9 Architects, Inc., and a representative of the Master 10 11 Gardener's Program. 12 (b) The Wildflower Advisory Council shall develop procedures of operation, research contracts, educational 13 14 programs, and wildflower planting grants for Florida native wildflowers, plants, and grasses. The council shall also make 15 the final determination of what constitutes acceptable species 16 of wildflowers and other plantings supported by these 17 programs. 18 19 Section 4. Any unencumbered balance of funds deposited 20 pursuant to section 320.08058(28), Florida Statutes, into the Wildflower Account of the Wildflower Advisory Council, Keep 21 Florida Beautiful, Inc., shall be transferred to the 22 Wildflower Account of the Wildflower Council within the 23 Florida Wildflower Foundation, Inc. 24 25 Section 5.
