Such presumption shall not apply to 4 benefits payable under or granted in a policy of life 5 insurance or disability insurance, unless the insurer and 6 insured have negotiated for such additional benefits to be 7 included in the policy contract.

(2) This section shall be construed to authorize the 8 above governmental entities to negotiate policy contracts for 9 10 life and disability insurance to include accidental death benefits or double indemnity coverage which shall include the 11 12 presumption that any condition or impairment of health of any firefighter, law enforcement officer, or correctional officer 13 14 caused by tuberculosis, heart disease, or hypertension 15 resulting in total or partial disability or death was accidental and suffered in the line of duty, unless the 16 17 contrary be shown by competent evidence.
