Section 440.091, Florida Statutes, is 14 amended to read: 15 440.091 Law enforcement officer or firefighter; when 16 acting within the course of employment .--17 (1) If an employee: (a)(1) Is elected, appointed, or employed full time by 18 a municipality, the state, or any political subdivision and is 19 vested with authority to bear arms and make arrests and the 20 21 employee's primary responsibility is the prevention or 2.2 detection of crime or the enforcement of the penal, criminal, 23 traffic, or highway laws of the state; 24 (b)(2) Was discharging that primary responsibility 25 within the state in a place and under circumstances reasonably 26 consistent with that primary responsibility; and 27 (c) (3) Was not engaged in services for which he or she was paid by a private employer, and the employee and his or 28 29 her public employer had no agreement providing for workers' 30 compensation coverage for that private employment; 31 1

the employee is considered shall be deemed to have been acting 1 within the course of employment. The term "employee" as used 2 in this subsection section includes all certified supervisory 3 and command personnel whose duties include, in whole or in 4 5 part, responsibilities for the supervision, training, guidance, and management of full-time law enforcement 6 7 officers, part-time law enforcement officers, or auxiliary law 8 enforcement officers but does not include support personnel 9 employed by the employing agency. 10 (2) If a firefighter as defined by s. 112.191(1)(b) is engaged in extinguishing a fire, or protecting and saving life 11 12 or property due to a fire in this state in an emergency, and 13 such activities would be considered to be within the course of 14 his or her employment as a firefighter and covered by the employer's workers' compensation coverage except for the fact 15 16 that the firefighter was off duty or that the location of the fire was outside the employer's jurisdiction or area of 17 responsibility, such activities are considered to be within 18 19 the course of employment. This subsection does not apply if 20 the firefighter is performing activities for which he or she is paid by another employer or contractor. 21 22 Section 2. It is declared by the Legislature that firefighters perform state and municipal functions, that it is 23 24 their duty to protect life and property at their own risk and peril, and that their activities are vital to the public 25 26 safety. Therefore, the Legislature declares that it fulfills 27 an important state interest to provide workers' compensation 28 coverage to firefighters while engaged in extinguishing a 29 fire, or protecting and saving life or property due to a fire in this state while off duty or engaging in such activities at 30 a fire located outside the employer's jurisdiction or area of 31

responsibility. Pursuant to Section 18, Article VII of the State Constitution, the Legislature determines and declares that the provisions of this act fulfill an important state interest. Section 3.
