17	Section 2. <u>(1) The Florida Public Service Commission</u>		
18	<u>in consultation with the Florida Department of Environmental</u>		
19	<u>Protection is directed to perform a study for the purpose of</u>		
20	<u>defining public policy with respect to the use of renewable</u>		
21	<u>resources in Florida. At a minimum, the study shall assess</u>		
22	<u>cost, feasibility, deployment schedules, and impacts on the</u>		
23	<u>environment of increased use of renewables. In addition, the</u>		
24	<u>study shall describe options and mechanisms to encourage the</u>		
25	<u>increased deployment of renewables within our state. The</u>		
26	<u>results of this study shall be submitted to the President of</u>		
27	<u>the Senate and the Speaker of the House by February 1, 2003.</u>		
28	(2) <u>As used in this section, the term:</u>		
29	(a) <u>"Biomass" means a power source that is comprised</u>		
30	<u>of, but not limited to, combustible residues or gasses from</u>		
31	<u>forest products manufacturing, agricultural and orchard crops,</u>

2 processing, urban wood waste, municipal solid waste, municipal

4 (b) "Green energy" means renewable energy.

7 following sources of energy, but not limited to: biomass;
8 municipal solid waste; geothermal energy; solar energy; wind
9 energy; wood waste; ocean thermal gradient power;
10 hydroelectric power; landfill gas; and agricultural products
