A bill to be entitled
An act relating to medical school eligibility
of United States military academy students or
graduates; repealing s. 458.3147, F.S., which
requires admission to any medical school within
the State University System of any Florida
resident who is a student at or graduate of any
of the United States military academies and has
complied with specified conditions, and which
limits such admissions; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 458.3147, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

HOUSE SUMMARY

Repeals current provision of law which requires admission to any medical school within the State University System of any Florida resident who is a student at or a graduate of any of the United States military academies and who has command approval to apply to medical school prior to assignment to the medical corps of the United States military, and which limits such admissions to two such applicants per academic year.
