Senate Amendment

On page 47, line 25, through
page 48, line 2, delete those lines

and insert: of Legal Affairs shall have the power to inspect, during normal business hours, the records of any pharmacy, wholesale establishment, or manufacturer, or any other place in the state in which drugs and medical supplies are manufactured, packed, packaged, made, stored, sold, or kept for sale, for the purpose of verifying the amount of drugs and medical supplies ordered, delivered, or purchased by a provider. The agency or Medicaid Fraud Control Unit of the Department of Legal Affairs shall provide at least 2 business days' prior notice of any such inspection. The notice must identify the provider whose records will be inspected and the inspection shall include only records specifically related to that provider.
