Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (1) of 18 section 893.13, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 19 893.13 Prohibited acts; penalties.--20 (1)(c) Except as authorized by this chapter, it is 21 22 unlawful for any person to sell, manufacture, or deliver, or 23 possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver a controlled substance in, on, or within 1,000 feet of the real 24 25 property comprising a child care facility as defined in s. 26 402.302, or a public or private elementary, middle, or 27 secondary school, or a state, county, or municipal park or 28 publicly owned recreational facility between the hours of 6 a.m. and 12 a.m. Any person who violates this paragraph with 29 30 respect to: 31
