19 Section 1. Section 20.193, Florida Statutes, is
20 created to read:

21 20.193 Department of Children and Family Services
22 direct-support organization.--

23 (1) As used in this section, the term "direct-support
24 organization" means a not-for-profit corporation incorporated
25 under chapter 617 and organized and operated to conduct
26 programs and activities; initiate developmental projects;
27 raise funds; request and receive grants, gifts, and bequests
28 of moneys; acquire, receive, hold, invest, and administer, in
29 its own name, securities, funds, objects of value, or other
30 property, real or personal; and make expenditures to or for
31 the direct or indirect benefit of the Department of Children

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1 and Family Services or individual programs or projects of the
2 department.

3 (2) A direct support organization may be organized to
4 accomplish the purposes and objectives set forth in subsection
5 (3) of this section. The direct support organization will
6 maintain donations and direct service expenditures in a bank
7 account outside of the State Treasury. Any administrative
8 costs of running and promoting the purposes of the corporation
9 will be paid for by private funds or state appropriations to
10 the extend the receipt of federal funding by the department is
11 not jeopardized.

12 (3) The purposes and objectives of the direct-support
13 organization must be consistent with the priority issues and
14 objectives of the department and must be in the best interest
15 of the state.

16 (4) Funds designated for the direct-support
17 organization shall be used for the enhancement of programs and
18 projects of the department.

19 (5) The department may permit, without charge, the
20 appropriate use of property and facilities of the state by the
21 direct-support organization subject to the provisions of this
22 section. Such use must be directly in keeping with the
23 approved purpose of the direct-support organization.

24 (6) The direct-support organization shall provide for
25 an annual financial audit in accordance with s. 215.981.

26 Section 2. Subsection (10) is added to section 20.19,
27 Florida Statutes, to read:

28 (10) SOLICITATION OF DONATIONS TO DIRECT-SUPPORT
29 ORGANIZATIONS.--The secretary may designate employees of the
30 department to solicit donations from public or private sources
31 pursuant to s. 20.193.

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1 Section 3. Section 430.065, Florida Statutes, is
2 created to read:

3 430.065 Department of Elder Affairs direct-support
4 organization.--

5 (1) As used in this section, the term "direct-support
6 organization" means a not-for-profit corporation incorporated
7 under chapter 617 and organized and operated to conduct
8 programs and activities; initiate developmental projects;

10 of moneys; acquire, receive, hold, invest, and administer, in
