Any gift by a direct-support organization, either direct or indirect, with a value in excess of \$1000 must be immediately reported to the community college board of trustees. report must include the following information: the amount of the gift or nature of the gift; the recipient of the gift; the direct relationship of the gift to the educational mission of the community college; and the direct benefit of the gift to the community college. The community college board of trustees shall forward such information to the State Board of Education by December 31 of each year.
