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programs and activities; initiate developmental projects; raise funds; request and receive grants, gifts, and bequests of moneys; acquire, receive, hold, invest, and administer, in its own name, securities, funds, objects of value, or other property, real or personal; and make expenditures to or for the direct or indirect benefit of the Department of Children and Family Services or individual programs or projects of the department.

- (2) A direct support organization may be organized to accomplish the purposes and objectives set forth in subsection (3) of this section. The direct support organization will maintain donations and direct service expenditures in a bank account outside of the State Treasury. Any administrative costs of running and promoting the purposes of the corporation will be paid for by private funds or state appropriations to the extend the receipt of federal funding by the department is not jeopardized.
- (3) The purposes and objectives of the direct-support organization must be consistent with the priority issues and objectives of the department and must be in the best interest of the state.
- (4) Funds designated for the direct-support organization shall be used for the enhancement of programs and projects of the department.
- (5) The department may permit, without charge, the appropriate use of property and facilities of the state by the direct-support organization subject to the provisions of this section. Such use must be directly in keeping with the approved purpose of the direct-support organization.
- (6) The direct-support organization shall provide for an annual financial audit in accordance with s. 215.981.
