Paragraph (a) of subsection (1) and paragraph (b) of subsection (3) of section 320.0848, Florida 10 11 Statutes, are amended to read: 320.0848 Persons who have disabilities; issuance of 12 disabled parking permits; temporary permits; permits for 13 14 certain providers of transportation services to persons who 15 have disabilities .--16 (1)(a) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor 17 Vehicles or its authorized agents shall, upon application and 18 receipt of the fee, issue a disabled parking permit for a 19 period of up to 4 years, which period ends on the applicant's 20 birthday, to any person who has long-term mobility impairment, or a temporary disabled parking permit not to exceed 6 months 21 1 year to any person who has a temporary mobility impairment. 22 23 (3) DISABLED PARKING PERMIT; TEMPORARY.--24 (b) The department shall issue the temporary disabled 25 parking permit for the period of the disability as stated by 26 the certifying physician, but not to exceed 6 months 1 year. 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1. 2002. 28 29 30 SENATE SUMMARY Reduces the term of a temporary parking permit for a disabled person from 1 year to 6 months. 31
