Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 2, lines 8-13, delete those lines

and insert: under the terms of a contract with the political
subdivision.

(4) No political subdivision of the state shall grant
a direct tax abatement or subsidy to an employer unless the
political subdivision in which the employer is doing business
requires, as a condition of the direct tax abatement or
subsidy, that the employer pay each of its employees employed
within this state a living wage, which is defined as an hourly
rate that provides an income at least equal to the poverty
level for a family of four, as established annually by the
United States Department of Health and Human Services.
