A bill to be entitled

An act relating to pharmaceutical expense assistance; amending s. 409.9065, F.S.; increasing the maximum income level for eligibility under the pharmaceutical expense assistance program; increasing the maximum monthly benefit amount per participant;

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) and subsection (3) of section 409.9065, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

409.9065 Pharmaceutical expense assistance.--

- (2) ELIGIBILITY.--Eligibility for the program is limited to those individuals who qualify for limited assistance under the Florida Medicaid program as a result of being dually eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid, but whose limited assistance or Medicare coverage does not include any pharmacy benefit. Specifically eligible are low-income senior citizens who:
- (b) Have an income between 90 and  $\underline{150}$   $\underline{120}$  percent of the federal poverty level;
- (3) BENEFITS.--Medications covered under the pharmaceutical expense assistance program are those covered under the Medicaid program in s. 409.906(20). Monthly benefit payments shall be limited to \$150\$00 per program participant. Participants are required to make a 10-percent coinsurance payment for each prescription purchased through this program. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.

\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\* HOUSE SUMMARY Increases from 120 percent to 150 percent of federal poverty level the maximum income for participation of an elderly individual in the pharmaceutical expense assistance program. Increases from \$80 to \$150 the monthly benefit limitation per participant.
