and insert:

Section 1. Enrique Valledor Way designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

(1) That portion of 22nd Street from 16th Avenue to 14th Avenue in the City of Miami in Miami-Dade County is hereby designated as "Enrique Valledor Way."

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Enrique Valledor Way as described in subsection (1).

Section 2. (1) The new Rose Bay bridges on U.S. Highway 1, between the Cities of New Smyrna Beach and Port Orange, are dedicated in honor of United States military personnel who were prisoners of war (POW's) or who are missing in action (MIA's).

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating the dedication in honor of

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1 POW's and MIA's.

2 Section 3. (1) That portion of I-275 which begins at
3 the Pinellas County end of the Howard Franklin Bridge and,
4 proceeding south, ends at the beginning of the Sunshine Skyway
5 Bridge is designated as the "St. Petersburg Parkway."

6 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
7 erect suitable markers designating the "St. Petersburg
8 Parkway" as described in subsection (1).

9 Section 4. "Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms
10 Special Agent Ariel Rios Memorial Way."--

11 (1) Northwest 87th Avenue in Miami-Dade County from
12 N.W. 41st Street to N.W. 52nd Street is designated "Bureau of
13 Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Special Agent Ariel Rios
14 Memorial Way".

15 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
16 erect suitable markers.

17 Section 5. "Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms
18 Special Agent Eddie Benitez Memorial Way."--

19 (1) Northwest 87th Avenue in Miami-Dade County from
20 N.W. 52nd Street to N.W. 58th Street is designated "Bureau of
21 Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Special Agent Eddie Benitez
22 Memorial Way".

23 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
24 erect suitable markers.

25 Section 6. Temple Terrace Parkway.--

26 (1) Notwithstanding section 334.071, Florida Statutes,
27 and chapter 67-789, Laws of Florida, State Road 580 within the
28 city limits of Temple Terrace, from the intersection of Busch
29 Boulevard and Overlook Drive through 56th Street, is renamed
30 "Temple Terrace Parkway."

31 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to

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1 erect suitable street signs indicating that the portion of
2 State Road 580 described in subsection (1) has been officially
3 renamed "Temple Terrace Parkway."

4 Section 7. Martin L. King, Jr., Drive designated;
5 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

6 (1) That portion of State Road 50 from Ocoee to State
7 Road 436 in Orange County is hereby designated as Martin L.
8 King, Jr., Drive.

9 (2) The Department of Transportation is hereby
10 directed to erect suitable markers designating Martin L. King,
11 Jr., Drive as described in subsection 1.

12 Section 8. "Judge Steve Levine Boulevard" designated;
13 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

14 (1) That portion of U.S. 1 between S.W. 216 Street and
15 S.W. 232 Street in Miami-Dade County is hereby designated as
16 Judge Steve Levine Boulevard.

17 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
18 erect suitable markers designating Judge Steve Levine
19 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

20 Section 9. Mamie Langdale Memorial Bridge designation;
21 markers.--

22 (1) The new U.S. Highway 27 bridge in the City of
23 Moore Haven in Glades County is hereby designated as the
24 "Mamie Langdale Memorial Bridge."

25 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
26 erect suitable markers designating the "Mamie Langdale
27 Memorial Bridge" as described in subsection (1).

28 Section 10. Veterans Memorial Bridge designation;
29 markers.--

30 (1) Bridge number 550122 on Thomasville Road in the
31 City of Tallahassee in Leon County is hereby designated as the

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1 "Veterans Memorial Bridge."

2 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
3 erect suitable markers designating the "Veterans Memorial
4 Bridge" as described in subsection (1).

5 Section 11. Doyle Parker Memorial Highway designation;
6 markers.--

7 (1) U.S. Highway 17 from Wauchula to Bowling Green is
8 hereby designated as the "Doyle Parker Memorial Highway."

9 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
10 erect suitable markers designating the "Doyle Parker Memorial
11 Highway" as described in subsection (1).

12 Section 12. Lynn Haven Parkway designation; markers.--

13 (1) That portion of State Road 77 between Baldwin Road
14 and Mowat School Road in the City of Lynn Haven in Bay County
15 is hereby designated as the "Lynn Haven Parkway."

16 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
17 erect suitable markers designating the "Lynn Haven Parkway" as
18 described in subsection (1).

19 Section 13. John S. "Steve" Dennard Bridge
20 designation; markers.--

21 (1) The New River Bridge (bridge number 390031) on
22 State Road 16 in Bradford and Union Counties is hereby
23 designated as the "John S. 'Steve' Dennard Bridge."

24 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
25 erect suitable markers designating the "John S. 'Steve'
26 Dennard Bridge" as described in subsection (1).

27 Section 14. Ed Fraser Memorial Highway designation;
28 markers.--

29 (1) State Road 121, from the Georgia-Florida line in
30 Baker County to the city limits of Lake Butler in Union
31 County, is hereby designated as the "Ed Fraser Memorial

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1 Highway."

2 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
3 erect suitable markers designating the "Ed Fraser Memorial
4 Highway" as described in subsection (1).

5 Section 15. Correctional Officers Memorial Highway
6 designation; markers.--

7 (1) That portion of State Road 16 from the
8 northwestern city limits of Starke in Bradford County to State
9 Road 121 in Union County is hereby designated as the
10 "Correctional Officers Memorial Highway."

11 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
12 erect suitable markers designating the "Correctional Officers
13 Memorial Highway" as described in subsection (1).

14 Section 16. Martin Luther King, Jr., Memorial Highway
15 designation; markers.--

16 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 41 located in White
17 Springs in Hamilton County is hereby designated as the "Martin
18 Luther King, Jr., Memorial Highway."

19 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
20 erect suitable markers designating the "Martin Luther King,
21 Jr., Memorial Highway" as described in subsection (1).

22 Section 17. Purple Heart Memorial Highway designation;
23 markers.--

24 (1) Interstate 75 from the Georgia-Florida state line
25 to the city limits of Ocala in Marion County is hereby
26 designated as the "Purple Heart Memorial Highway."

27 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
28 erect suitable markers designating the "Purple Heart Memorial
29 Highway" as described in subsection (1).

30 Section 18. Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway
31 designation; markers.--

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1 (1) Highway 417 in Seminole County is hereby
2 designated as the "Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway."

3 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
4 erect suitable markers designating the "Korean War Veterans
5 Memorial Highway" as described in subsection (1).

6 Section 19. Jerome A. Williams Memorial Highway
7 designation; markers.--

8 (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 17 from Crescent City
9 south to the Putnam/Volusia County boundary is hereby
10 designated as the "Jerome A. Williams Memorial Highway."

11 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
12 erect suitable markers designating the "Jerome A. Williams
13 Memorial Highway" as described in subsection (1).

14 Section 20. "Veterans Memorial Highway" designation;
15 markers.--

16 (1) That portion of State Road 100, beginning at the
17 western city limits of the Town of Flagler Beach in Flagler
18 County and continuing east to the eastern city limits of the
19 Town of Bunnell, is hereby designated as the "Veterans
20 Memorial Highway."

21 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
22 erect suitable markers designating the "Veterans Memorial
23 Highway" as described in subsection (1).

24 Section 21. Private Robert M. McTureous, Jr.,
25 U.S.M.C., Medal of Honor Memorial Highway designated.--

26 (1) That portion of State Road 19 in Lake County from
27 the north end of Lake County to the intersection of State Road
28 19 and Highway 441 in Eustis is hereby designated as the
29 "Private Robert M. McTureous, Jr., U.S.M.C., Medal of Honor
30 Memorial Highway."

31 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to

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1 erect suitable markers designating the Private Robert M.
2 McTureous, Jr., U.S.M.C., Medal of Honor Memorial Highway as
3 described in subsection (1).

4 Section 22. "Steven Cranman Boulevard" and "Ethel
5 Beckford Boulevard" designated; Department of Transportation
6 to erect suitable markers.--

7 (1) That portion of U.S. 1 between S.W. 136th Street
8 and S.W. 186th Street in Miami-Dade County is hereby
9 designated as Steven Cranman Boulevard. The Department of
10 Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers
11 designating Steven Cranman Boulevard as described in this
12 subsection.

13 (2) That portion of S.W. 186th Street between U.S. 1
14 and S.W. 107th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is hereby
15 designated as Ethel Beckford Boulevard. The Department of
16 Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers
17 designating Ethel Beckford Boulevard as described in this
18 subsection.

19 Section 23. "Phicol Williams Boulevard" designated;
20 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

21 (1) That portion of State Road 5 (U.S. 1) between S.W.
22 312th Street and S.W. 328th Street in Miami-Dade County is
23 hereby designated as Phicol Williams Boulevard.

24 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
25 erect suitable markers designating Phicol Williams Boulevard
26 as described in subsection (1).

27 Section 24. "Arthur Mays Boulevard" designated;
28 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

29 (1) That portion of S.W. 112 Avenue from U.S. 1 to
30 S.W. 230 Street in Miami-Dade County is hereby designated as
31 Arthur Mays Boulevard.

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1 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
2 erect suitable markers designating Arthur Mays Boulevard as
3 described in subsection (1).

4 Section 25. "Jean-Jacques Dessalines Boulevard"
5 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
6 markers.--

7 (1) State Road 934 on N.W. 79th Street in Miami-Dade
8 County, from the west boundary of State House District 108 to
9 the east boundary of district 108, is hereby designated as
10 Jean-Jacques Dessalines Boulevard.

11 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
12 erect suitable markers designating Jean-Jacques Dessalines
13 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

14 Section 26. "Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard"
15 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
16 markers.--

17 (1) State Road 922 on N.W. 125th Street in Miami-Dade
18 County, from N.W. 7th Avenue to Griffin Boulevard, is hereby
19 designated as Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard.

20 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
21 erect suitable markers designating Toussaint L'Ouverture
22 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

23 Section 27. "Frederick Douglass Boulevard" designated;
24 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

25 (1) State Road 915 on N.E. 6th Avenue in Miami-Dade
26 County, from the north boundary of State House District 108 to
27 U.S. 1, is hereby designated as Frederick Douglass Boulevard.

28 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
29 erect suitable markers designating Frederick Douglass
30 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

31 Section 28. Borinquen Boulevard designation;

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1 markers.--

2 (1) That portion of North 36th Street (State Road 25)
3 from Biscayne Boulevard to N.W. 7th Avenue is hereby
4 designated "Borinquen Boulevard" in honor of Miami-Dade
5 County's Puerto Rican community.

6 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
7 erect suitable markers designating the "Borinquen Boulevard"
8 as described in subsection (1).

9 Section 29. "South Miami All-American Parkway"
10 designation; markers.--

11 (1) U.S. 1 from 57th Avenue to S.W. 80th Street in
12 Miami-Dade County is designated as "South Miami All-American
13 Parkway."

14 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
15 erect suitable markers designating "South Miami All-American
16 Parkway" as described in subsection (1).

17 Section 30. Monsignor Bryan O. Walsh Boulevard
18 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
19 markers.--

20 (1) Northeast 21st Street from Biscayne Boulevard to
21 Biscayne Bay in Miami is hereby designated as "Monsignor Bryan
22 O. Walsh Boulevard."

23 (2) The Department of Transportation is hereby
24 directed to erect suitable markers designating "Monsignor
25 Bryan O. Walsh Boulevard" as described in subsection (1).

26 Section 31. Johnnie Mae Chappell Memorial Highway
27 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable
28 markers.--

29 (1) The portion of Edgewood Avenue West in Duval
30 County between Moncrief Road and U.S. 1 is hereby designated
31 "Johnnie Mae Chappell Memorial Highway."

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1 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to
2 erect suitable markers designating "Johnnie Mae Chappell
3 Memorial Highway" as described in subsection (1).

4 Section 32. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
