Trust Fund is created to be administered by the Department of 12 Education. Legislative appropriations provided to match 13 14 qualified tax exemptions that are designated by the 15 beneficiary to be used by a state university or community college pursuant to the provisions of s. 212.08(5)(j)8., 16 17 Florida Statutes, shall be credited to the trust fund to be 18 used for the purposes set forth therein. Section 2. Pursuant to the provisions of s. 19(f)(2), 19 20 Art. III of the State Constitution, the High Technology Tax 21 Exemption Matching Trust Fund shall, unless terminated sooner, 2.2 be terminated on July 1, 2006. Prior to its scheduled 23 termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in 24 s. 215.3206, Florida Statutes. 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002. 26 27 28 HOUSE SUMMARY 29 Creates the High Technology Tax Exemption Matching Trust Fund, provides a source of funds and purpose for the fund, and provides for future review and termination or 30 re-creation of the fund. 31
