Section 24. Subsection (4) and (5) are added to section 320.275, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.275 Automobile Dealers Industry Advisory Board.--

(4) A technical advisory committee is created to advise the Automobile Dealers Industry Advisory Board. The committee, from its own initiative, may make recommendations to the board on proposed legislation and proposed rules and procedures, may consider any matters relating to the motor vehicle dealer industry, and may make recommendations on consumer education and information, and submit an annual report to the board. The technical advisory committee shall be composed of one representative from a senior citizens organization; one representative from an organization representing low-income Floridians; one representative from the consumer affairs division of a county or city; one
