The department shall contract 6 with the Florida Association of Court Clerks and the 7 depositories to design, establish, operate, upgrade, and maintain the automation of the depositories to include, but 8 not be limited to, the provision of on-line electronic 10 transfer of information to the IV-D agency as otherwise 11 required by this chapter. The department's obligation to fund 12 the automation of the depositories is limited to the state share of funds available in the Clerk of the Court Child 13 14 Support Enforcement Collection System Trust Fund. 15 depository created under this section shall fully participate 16 in the Clerk of the Court Child Support Enforcement Collection 17 System and transmit data in a readable format as required by the contract between the Florida Association of Court Clerks 18 and the department. 19

- For each support payment of less than \$33, 18.75 cents.
- b. For each support payment between \$33 and \$140, an amount equal to 18.75 percent of the fee charged.
- For each support payment in excess of \$140, 18.75 cents.
- The fees established by this section shall be set 3. forth and included in every order of support entered by a 31 court of this state which requires payment to be made into the
