BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with the 17 requirements of section 101.161, Florida Statutes, the title 18 19 and substance of the amendment proposed herein shall appear on the ballot as follows: 20 21 2.2 ADMISSION AND DISCIPLINE OF ATTORNEYS 23 24 25 Proposes to replace the Supreme Court with the Department of 26 Business and Professional Regulation, or its successor, as the 27 entity responsible for the admission of persons to practice 28 law and the discipline of persons admitted to practice law. 29 30 31
