11	Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 106.08, Florida
12	Statutes, is reenacted and amended to read:

14	(5) <u>(a)</u> A person may not make any contribution through
15	or in the name of another, directly or indirectly, in any
16	election.
17	(b) Candidates, political committees, and political
18	parties may not solicit contributions from or make
19	contributions to any religious, charitable, civic, or other
20	causes or organizations established primarily for the public
21	good.
22	(c) Candidates, political committees, and political
23	parties may not make contributions, in exchange for political
24	support, to any religious, charitable, civic, or other cause
25	or organization established primarily for the public good.
26	However,It is not a violation of this <u>paragraph</u> subsection
27	for <u>:</u>
28	<u>1.</u> A candidate, political committee, or political
29	party executive committee to make gifts of money in lieu of
30	flowers in memory of a deceased person ;or for

16	campaign contributions; and, limits the prohibition in current statute against candidates, political committees, and		
17	political parties making contributions to charitable organizations to only those contributions made in exchange for		
18	political support.
