A bill to be entitled

An act relating to jurors; amending s. 40.01, F.S.; providing for jurors to be taken from registered electors, rather than from persons possessing a driver's license or identification card; amending s. 40.011, F.S.; deleting provisions requiring the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to send lists of persons in the departmental database to the clerks of court; amending s. 40.022, F.S., relating to purging jury selection lists, to conform to the amendment made by this act; amending s. 98.095, F.S.; providing for voter lists to be used for jury selection; amending s. 322.20, F.S.; deleting a requirement that the department provide certain information to the courts; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 40.01, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

40.01 Qualifications of jurors.--Jurors shall be taken from the male and female persons at least 18 years of age who are citizens of the United States and legal residents of this state and who are registered electors of their respective counties and who possess a driver's license or identification card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles pursuant to chapter 322 or who have executed the affidavit prescribed in s. 40.011.

Section 2. Subsection (1) of section 40.011, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

40.011 Jury lists.--

(1) On or before January 1, 1993, and each year thereafter by January 1, the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles shall deliver to the clerk of the circuit court in each county a list of names, along with mailing addresses and dates of birth, of each person 18 years of age or older whose name appears in the department database and whose address is in that county. By January 1, 1992, the department shall begin the process of identifying persons whose names appear in the department database who are not citizens of the United States and legal residents of this state for the purpose of jury selection. By January 1, 1998, the department database list delivered to the clerk of the circuit court in each county may include only the names of persons who are citizens of the United States and legal residents of Florida and whose address is in that county and who are 18 years of age or older. The clerk of the circuit court shall add to the list of prospective jurors the name of any person who is 18 years of age or older and who is a citizen of the United States and a legal resident of Florida and who indicates a desire to serve as a juror, but whose name does not appear on the list of registered voters department database list, by requiring such person to execute an affidavit at the office of the clerk.

Section 3. Subsection (1) of section 40.022, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

40.022 Clerk to purge jury selection lists; restoration.--

1 (1) Each clerk of the circuit court shall, upon 2 receipt of the list of registered voters persons in the 3 department database from the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and at least once each month thereafter, purge 4 5 the jury selection lists of the names of those persons: (a) Adjudicated mentally incompetent; 6 7 (b) Convicted of a felony; or 8 (c) Deceased. 9 Section 4. Section 5. Subsection (9) of section 322.20, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

322.20 Records of the department; fees; destruction of records.--

The department may, upon application, furnish to any person, from the records of the Division of Driver Licenses, a list of the names, addresses, and birth dates of the licensed drivers of the entire state or any portion thereof by age group. In addition, the department may furnish to the courts, for the purpose of establishing jury selection lists, the names, addresses, and birth dates of the persons of the entire state or any portion thereof by age group having identification cards issued by the department. Each person who requests such information shall pay a fee, set by the department, of 1 cent per name listed, except that the department shall furnish such information without charge to the courts for the purpose of jury selection or to any state agency or to any state attorney, sheriff, or chief of police. Such court, state agency, state attorney, or law enforcement agency may not sell, give away, or allow the copying of such information. Noncompliance with this prohibition shall authorize the department to charge the noncomplying court, any state agency, state attorney, or law enforcement agency the appropriate fee for any subsequent lists requested. The department may adopt rules necessary to implement this subsection.

Section 6. This act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
