Paragraph (e) is added to subsection (5) of 19 section 229.0073, Florida Statutes, to read: 20 229.0073 Reorganization of the Department of Education.--Effective July 1, 2001, notwithstanding the 21 22 provisions of s. 20.15, the secretary's Education 23 Reorganization Workgroup is established to direct and provide oversight for the reorganization of Florida's K-20 Department 24 25 of Education. The workgroup shall be comprised of the 26 Secretary of the Florida Board of Education, the Commissioner 27 of Education, the Governor or his designee, the Chancellor of Colleges and Universities, the Chancellor of Community 28 29 Colleges, the Chancellor of Public Schools, and the Executive Director of Independent Education, who shall consult with the 30 31

legislative members of the Education Governance Reorganization 1 2 Transition Task Force. The reorganization shall: 3 Establish the following offices within the Office (5)of the Commissioner of Education which shall coordinate their 4 5 activities with all other divisions and offices: б (e) Office of Inspector General. -- The office shall be 7 organized using existing resources and funds and shall be responsible for promoting accountability, efficiency, and 8 9 effectiveness and detecting fraud and abuse within school 10 districts, public community colleges, and public universities in this state. The office shall conduct, coordinate, or 11 request investigations into substantiated allegations made by 12 any person relating to waste, fraud, or financial 13 mismanagement within school districts, public community 14 15 colleges, and public universities in this state. The office shall have access to all information and personnel necessary 16 to the performance of its duties and shall have all of its 17 18 current powers, duties, and responsibilities authorized in s. 19 20.055.
