16          Terrace Parkway"; designating a portion of  
17          State Road 50 in Orange County as Martin L.  
18          King, Jr., Drive; designating "Judge Steve  
19          Levine Boulevard" in Miami-Dade County;  
20          designating the new U.S. Highway 27 road and  
21          bridge in the City of Moore Haven as the "Mamie  
22          Langdale Memorial Bridge"; designating the old

24          Counties as the "George Crady Bridge";  
25          designating bridge number 550122 in Tallahassee  
26          as the "Veterans Memorial Bridge"; designating  
27          a portion of U.S. Highway 17 as the "Doyle  
28          Parker Memorial Highway"; designating a portion  
29          of State Road 77 as the "Lynn Haven Parkway";  
30          designating the New River Bridge in Bradford  
31          and Union Counties as the "John S. 'Steve'

1 Dennard Bridge"; designating a portion of State  
2 Road 121 as the "Ed Fraser Memorial Highway";  
3 designating a portion of State Road 16 as the  
4 "Correctional Officers Memorial Highway";  
5 designating a portion of U.S. Highway 41 in  
6 White Springs as the "Martin Luther King, Jr.,  
7 Memorial Highway"; designating a portion of  
8 Interstate 75 as the "Purple Heart Memorial  
9 Highway"; designating the "Korean War Veterans  
10 Memorial Highway" in Seminole County;  
11 designating a portion of U.S. Highway 17 as the  
12 "Jerome A. Williams Memorial Highway";  
13 designating a portion of State Road 100 in  
14 Flagler County as Veterans Memorial Highway;  
15 designating a portion of Semoran Boulevard in  
16 the City of Orlando, Orange County, as "Toni  
17 Jennings Boulevard"; designating a portion of  
18 State Road 19 in Lake County as the "Private  
19 Robert M. McTureous, Jr., U.S.M.C., Medal of  
20 Honor Memorial Highway"; designating "Steven  
21 Cranman Boulevard" and "Ethel Beckford  
22 Boulevard" in Miami-Dade County; designating  
23 "Phicol Williams Boulevard" in Miami-Dade  
24 County; designating "Arthur Mays Boulevard" in  
25 Miami-Dade County; designating "Jean-Jacques  
26 Dessalines Boulevard" in Miami-Dade County;  
27 designating "Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard"  
28 in Miami-Dade County; designating "Frederick  
29 Douglass Boulevard" in Miami-Dade County;  
30 designating "Dr. Luis Conte-Aguero Way" in  
31 Miami-Dade County; designating "Olga Choren and

1 Tony Alvarez Way" in Miami-Dade County;  
2 designating the "L.E. Buie bridge in Miami-Dade  
3 County; designating "Borinquen Boulevard" in  
4 Miami-Dade County; designating 96th Street in  
5 Miami-Dade County as the "Stanley Whitman  
6 Boulevard"; designating Miami Gardens Drive as  
7 the "Ronald A. Silver Boulevard"; designating  
8 the "All-American Parkway" in Miami-Dade  
9 County; directing the Department of  
10 Transportation to erect suitable markers;  
11 designating the "Senator Ginny Brown-Waite  
12 Highway" in Hernando County; directing the  
13 Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
14 markers; designating a portion of Golfair  
15 Boulevard in Jacksonville as "Holzendorf  
16 Boulevard"; providing an effective date.

18 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:  
19

20 Section 1. Enrique Valledor Way designated; Department  
21 of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

22 (1) That portion of 22nd Street from 16th Avenue to  
23 14th Avenue in the City of Miami in Miami-Dade County is  
24 hereby designated as "Enrique Valledor Way."

25 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
26 erect suitable markers designating Enrique Valledor Way as  
27 described in subsection (1).

28 Section 2. (1) The new Rose Bay bridges on U.S.  
29 Highway 1, between the Cities of New Smyrna Beach and Port  
30 Orange, are dedicated in honor of United States military  
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1 personnel who were prisoners of war (POW's) or who are missing  
2 in action (MIA's).

3 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
4 erect suitable markers designating the dedication in honor of  
5 POW's and MIA's.

6 Section 3. (1) That portion of I-275 which begins at  
7 the Pinellas County end of the Howard Franklin Bridge and,  
8 proceeding south, ends at the beginning of the Sunshine Skyway  
9 Bridge is designated as the "St. Petersburg Parkway."

10 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
11 erect suitable markers designating the "St. Petersburg  
12 Parkway" as described in subsection (1).

13 Section 4. "Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms  
14 Special Agent Ariel Rios Memorial Way."--

15 (1) Northwest 87th Avenue in Miami-Dade County from  
16 N.W. 41st Street to N.W. 52nd Street is designated "Bureau of  
17 Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Special Agent Ariel Rios  
18 Memorial Way".

19 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
20 erect suitable markers.

21 Section 5. "Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms  
22 Special Agent Eddie Benitez Memorial Way."--

23 (1) Northwest 87th Avenue in Miami-Dade County from  
24 N.W. 52nd Street to N.W. 58th Street is designated "Bureau of  
25 Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms Special Agent Eddie Benitez  
26 Memorial Way".

27 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
28 erect suitable markers.

29 Section 6. Temple Terrace Parkway.--

30 (1) Notwithstanding section 334.071, Florida Statutes,  
31 and chapter 67-789, Laws of Florida, State Road 580 within the

1 city limits of Temple Terrace, from the intersection of Busch  
2 Boulevard and Overlook Drive through 56th Street, is renamed  
3 "Temple Terrace Parkway."

4 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
5 erect suitable street signs indicating that the portion of  
6 State Road 580 described in subsection (1) has been officially  
7 renamed "Temple Terrace Parkway."

8 Section 7. Martin L. King, Jr., Drive designated;  
9 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

10 (1) That portion of State Road 50 from Ocoee to State  
11 Road 436 in Orange County is hereby designated as Martin L.  
12 King, Jr., Drive.

13 (2) The Department of Transportation is hereby  
14 directed to erect suitable markers designating Martin L. King,  
15 Jr., Drive as described in subsection 1.

16 Section 8. "Judge Steve Levine Boulevard" designated;  
17 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

18 (1) That portion of U.S. 1 between S.W. 216 Street and  
19 S.W. 232 Street in Miami-Dade County is hereby designated as  
20 Judge Steve Levine Boulevard.

21 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
22 erect suitable markers designating Judge Steve Levine  
23 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

24 Section 9. Mamie Langdale Memorial Bridge designation;  
25 markers.--

26 (1) The new U.S. Highway 27 bridge in the City of  
27 Moore Haven in Glades County is hereby designated as the  
28 "Mamie Langdale Memorial Bridge."

29 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
30 erect suitable markers designating the "Mamie Langdale  
31 Memorial Bridge" as described in subsection (1).

1           Section 10. George Crady Bridge designation;  
2 markers.--

3           (1) The old Nassau Sound Bridge (bridge number 750055)  
4 on State Road 105 in Nassau and Duval Counties is hereby  
5 redesignated as the "George Crady Bridge."

6           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
7 erect suitable markers designating the "George Crady Bridge"  
8 as described in subsection (1).

9           Section 11. Veterans Memorial Bridge designation;  
10 markers.--

11           (1) Bridge number 550122 on Thomasville Road in the  
12 City of Tallahassee in Leon County is hereby designated as the  
13 "Veterans Memorial Bridge."

14           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
15 erect suitable markers designating the "Veterans Memorial  
16 Bridge" as described in subsection (1).

17           Section 12. Doyle Parker Memorial Highway designation;  
18 markers.--

19           (1) U.S. Highway 17 from Wauchula to Bowling Green is  
20 hereby designated as the "Doyle Parker Memorial Highway."

21           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
22 erect suitable markers designating the "Doyle Parker Memorial  
23 Highway" as described in subsection (1).

24           Section 13. Lynn Haven Parkway designation; markers.--

25           (1) That portion of State Road 77 between Baldwin Road  
26 and Mowat School Road in the City of Lynn Haven in Bay County  
27 is hereby designated as the "Lynn Haven Parkway."

28           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
29 erect suitable markers designating the "Lynn Haven Parkway" as  
30 described in subsection (1).

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1           Section 14. John S. "Steve" Dennard Bridge  
2 designation; markers.--

3           (1) The New River Bridge (bridge number 390031) on  
4 State Road 16 in Bradford and Union Counties is hereby  
5 designated as the "John S. 'Steve' Dennard Bridge."

6           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
7 erect suitable markers designating the "John S. 'Steve'  
8 Dennard Bridge" as described in subsection (1).

9           Section 15. Ed Fraser Memorial Highway designation;  
10 markers.--

11           (1) State Road 121, from the Georgia-Florida line in  
12 Baker County to the city limits of Lake Butler in Union  
13 County, is hereby designated as the "Ed Fraser Memorial  
14 Highway."

15           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
16 erect suitable markers designating the "Ed Fraser Memorial  
17 Highway" as described in subsection (1).

18           Section 16. Correctional Officers Memorial Highway  
19 designation; markers.--

20           (1) That portion of State Road 16 from the  
21 northwestern city limits of Starke in Bradford County to State  
22 Road 121 in Union County is hereby designated as the  
23 "Correctional Officers Memorial Highway."

24           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
25 erect suitable markers designating the "Correctional Officers  
26 Memorial Highway" as described in subsection (1).

27           Section 17. Martin Luther King, Jr., Memorial Highway  
28 designation; markers.--

29           (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 41 located in White  
30 Springs in Hamilton County is hereby designated as the "Martin  
31 Luther King, Jr., Memorial Highway."

1           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
2 erect suitable markers designating the "Martin Luther King,  
3 Jr., Memorial Highway" as described in subsection (1).

4           Section 18. Purple Heart Memorial Highway designation;  
5 markers.--

6           (1) Interstate 75 from the Georgia-Florida state line  
7 to the city limits of Ocala in Marion County is hereby  
8 designated as the "Purple Heart Memorial Highway."

9           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
10 erect suitable markers designating the "Purple Heart Memorial  
11 Highway" as described in subsection (1).

12           Section 19. Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway  
13 designation; markers.--

14           (1) Highway 417 in Seminole County is hereby  
15 designated as the "Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway."

16           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
17 erect suitable markers designating the "Korean War Veterans  
18 Memorial Highway" as described in subsection (1).

19           Section 20. Jerome A. Williams Memorial Highway  
20 designation; markers.--

21           (1) That portion of U.S. Highway 17 from Crescent City  
22 south to the Putnam/Volusia County boundary is hereby  
23 designated as the "Jerome A. Williams Memorial Highway."

24           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
25 erect suitable markers designating the "Jerome A. Williams  
26 Memorial Highway" as described in subsection (1).

27           Section 21. "Veterans Memorial Highway" designation;  
28 markers.--

29           (1) That portion of State Road 100, beginning at the  
30 western city limits of the Town of Flagler Beach in Flagler  
31 County and continuing east to the eastern city limits of the



1 Town of Bunnell, is hereby designated as the "Veterans  
2 Memorial Highway."

3 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
4 erect suitable markers designating the "Veterans Memorial  
5 Highway" as described in subsection (1).

6 Section 22. Toni Jennings Boulevard designated;  
7 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

8 (1) That portion of Semoran Boulevard in the City of  
9 Orlando in Orange County beginning at the Bee Line Expressway  
10 (State Road 528) on the South to Curry Ford Road on the North  
11 is hereby designated as "Toni Jennings Boulevard."

12 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
13 erect suitable markers designating the "Toni Jennings  
14 Boulevard" as described in subsection (1).

15 Section 23. Private Robert M. McTureous, Jr.,  
16 U.S.M.C., Medal of Honor Memorial Highway designated.--

17 (1) That portion of State Road 19 in Lake County from  
18 the north end of Lake County to the intersection of State Road  
19 19 and Highway 441 in Eustis is hereby designated as the  
20 "Private Robert M. McTureous, Jr., U.S.M.C., Medal of Honor  
21 Memorial Highway."

22 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
23 erect suitable markers designating the Private Robert M.  
24 McTureous, Jr., U.S.M.C., Medal of Honor Memorial Highway as  
25 described in subsection (1).

26 Section 24. "Steven Cranman Boulevard" and "Ethel  
27 Beckford Boulevard" designated; Department of Transportation  
28 to erect suitable markers.--

29 (1) That portion of U.S. 1 between S.W. 136th Street  
30 and S.W. 186th Street in Miami-Dade County is hereby  
31 designated as Steven Cranman Boulevard. The Department of

1 Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers  
2 designating Steven Cranman Boulevard as described in this  
3 subsection.

4 (2) That portion of S.W. 186th Street between U.S. 1  
5 and S.W. 107th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is hereby  
6 designated as Ethel Beckford Boulevard. The Department of  
7 Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers  
8 designating Ethel Beckford Boulevard as described in this  
9 subsection.

10 Section 25. "Phicol Williams Boulevard" designated;  
11 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

12 (1) That portion of State Road 5 (U.S. 1) between S.W.  
13 312th Street and S.W. 328th Street in Miami-Dade County is  
14 hereby designated as Phicol Williams Boulevard.

15 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
16 erect suitable markers designating Phicol Williams Boulevard  
17 as described in subsection (1).

18 Section 26. "Arthur Mays Boulevard" designated;  
19 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

20 (1) That portion of S.W. 112 Avenue from U.S. 1 to  
21 S.W. 230 Street in Miami-Dade County is hereby designated as  
22 Arthur Mays Boulevard.

23 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
24 erect suitable markers designating Arthur Mays Boulevard as  
25 described in subsection (1).

26 Section 27. "Jean-Jacques Dessalines Boulevard"  
27 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
28 markers.--

29 (1) State Road 934 on N.W. 79th Street in Miami-Dade  
30 County, from the west boundary of State House District 108 to  
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1 the east boundary of district 108, is hereby designated as  
2 Jean-Jacques Dessalines Boulevard.

3 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
4 erect suitable markers designating Jean-Jacques Dessalines  
5 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

6 Section 28. "Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard"  
7 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
8 markers.--

9 (1) State Road 922 on N.W. 125th Street in Miami-Dade  
10 County, from N.W. 7th Avenue to Griffin Boulevard, is hereby  
11 designated as Toussaint L'Ouverture Boulevard.

12 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
13 erect suitable markers designating Toussaint L'Ouverture  
14 Boulevard as described in subsection (1).

15 Section 29. "Frederick Douglass Boulevard" designated;  
16 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

17 (1) State Road 915 on N.E. 6th Avenue in Miami-Dade  
18 County, from the north boundary of State House District 108 to  
19 U.S. 1, is hereby designated as Frederick Douglass Boulevard.

20 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
21 erect suitable markers designating Frederick Douglass Boulevard  
22 as described in subsection (1).

23 Section 30. "Dr. Luis Conte-Aguero Way" designated;  
24 Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.--

25 (1) That portion of S.W. 24th Street (Coral Way)  
26 between 25th Avenue and 28th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is  
27 hereby designated as "Dr. Luis Conte-Aguero Way".

28 (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
29 erect suitable markers designating Dr. Luis Conte-Aguero Way  
30 as described in subsection (1).

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1           Section 31. "Olga Choren and Tony Alvarez Way"  
2 designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable  
3 markers.--

4           (1) That portion of S.W. 8th Street between 27th  
5 Avenue and 32nd Avenue in Miami-Dade County is hereby  
6 designated as "Olga Choren and Tony Alvarez Way".

7           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
8 erect suitable markers designating "Olga Choren and Tony  
9 Alvarez Way" as described in subsection (1).

10          Section 32. "L. E. Buie" Bridge designation;  
11 markers.--

12          (1) The Skypass Bridge (bridge number 930470) in the  
13 City of Riviera Beach in Palm Beach County is designated as  
14 the "L. E. Buie Bridge."

15          (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
16 erect suitable markers designating the "L. E. Buie" Bridge as  
17 described in subsection (1).

18          Section 33. Borinquen Boulevard designation;  
19 markers.--

20          (1) That portion of North 36th Street (State Road 25)  
21 from Biscayne Boulevard to N.W. 7th Avenue is hereby  
22 designated "Borinquen Boulevard" in honor of Miami-Dade  
23 County's Puerto Rican community.

24          (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
25 erect suitable markers designating the "Borinquen Boulevard"  
26 as described in subsection (1).

27          Section 34. "Stanley Whitman Boulevard" designation;  
28 markers.--

29          (1) Designating the portion of State Road 922 (96th  
30 Street) which provides entry and exit into the Bal Harbour  
31 Shops as "Stanley Whitman Boulevard".

1           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
2 erect suitable markers designating "Stanley Whitman Boulevard"  
3 as described in subsection (1).

4           Section 35. "Ronald A. Silver Boulevard" designation;  
5 markers.--

6           (1) Designating Miami Gardens Drive from U.S. 1 to 441  
7 as the "Ronald A. Silver Boulevard".

8           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
9 erect suitable markers designating "Ronald A. Silver  
10 Boulevard" as described in subsection (1).

11           Section 36. "South Miami All-American Parkway"  
12 designation; markers.--

13           (1) U.S. 1 from 57th Avenue to S.W. 80th Street in  
14 Miami-Dade County is designated as "South Miami All-American  
15 Parkway."

16           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
17 erect suitable markers designating "South Miami All-American  
18 Parkway" as described in subsection (1).

19           Section 37. "Senator Ginny Brown-Waite Highway"  
20 designation; markers.--

21           (1) State Road 50 from U.S. 75 to U.S. 19 in Hernando  
22 County is designated as the "Senator Ginny Brown-Waite  
23 Highway."

24           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
25 erect suitable markers designating the "Senator Ginny  
26 Brown-Waite Highway" as described in subsection (1).

27           Section 38. (1) That portion of Golfair Boulevard  
28 from Interstate Highway 95 to Moncrief Road in the City of  
29 Jacksonville is designated "Holzendorf Boulevard."

30           (2) The Department of Transportation is directed to  
31 erect suitable markers designating "Holzendorf Boulevard."

1           Section 39. This act shall take effect upon becoming a  
2 law.  
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
