Section 1. Subsection (16) is added to section 901.15,
Florida Statutes, to read:

901.15 When arrest by officer without warrant is
lawful.--A law enforcement officer may arrest a person without
a warrant when:

(16) There is probable cause to believe that the
person has committed assault upon a law enforcement officer, a
firefighter, an emergency medical care provider, public
transit employees or agents, or other specified officers as
set forth in s. 784.07 or has committed assault or battery
upon any employee of a receiving facility as defined in s.
394.455 who is engaged in the lawful performance of his or her
duties.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.
