**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove everything after the enacting clause

and insert:

Section 1. Section 256.15, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

256.15 Display of U.S. flag; prohibition unlawful; penalty.--

(1) It is unlawful for any person to prohibit:

(a) The display of the flag of the United States, or

(b) The display of the flag of the United States by means of a portable, removable flag pole.

(2) A violation of this section constitutes a noncriminal violation. The first violation shall be punished by fine in an amount not to exceed \$500. A second or subsequent violation shall be punished by fine in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.

Section 2. This act applies retroactively regardless of any declaration rules or requirements of homeowners'
