A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the City of Clearwater; providing for the relief of Eva Skowronek, as the widow of Wieslaw Skowronek, and for the relief of Anna Marie Skowronek, Victor Skowronek, and Hubert Skowronek, the children of Wieslaw Skowronek; providing appropriations to compensate them for the death of Wieslaw Skowronek as a result of the negligence of the City of Clearwater; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, on Sunday, January 19, 1997, Wieslaw Skowronek was visiting the Virgin Mary apparition at the Seminole Finance Building in Clearwater, Florida, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the use of excessive force by a City of Clearwater police officer, Wieslaw Skowronek's pancreas was ruptured and he bled to death, and

WHEREAS, the death of Wieslaw Skowronek was clearly the consequence of the negligence of the City of Clearwater, and

WHEREAS, the City of Clearwater and Eva Skowronek have entered into a settlement agreement in which the City of Clearwater has agreed to a settlement in the amount of \$525,000, of which the City of Clearwater will pay \$200,000, Ranger Insurance Company will pay \$125,000, and a claim bill will be submitted for the remaining \$200,000, and

WHEREAS, the City of Clearwater has paid the \$200,000, which is the maximum amount allowable under s. 768.28, Florida Statutes, and Ranger Insurance Company has paid \$125,000, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 1 2 3 Section 1. The facts stated in the preamble to this act are found and declared to be true. 4 5 Section 2. (1) The City of Clearwater is authorized 6 and directed to compensate Eva Skowronek, as the widow of 7 Wieslaw Skowronek, and Anna Marie Skowronek, Victor Skowronek, 8 and Hubert Skowronek, children of Wieslaw Skowronek, for the 9 death of Wieslaw Skowronek due to the negligence of a City of Clearwater employee, in the following amounts: 10 11 (a) \$100,000 to Eva Skowronek, as the widow of Wieslaw 12 Skowronek. 13 (b) \$33,333.33 to Anna Marie Skowronek, age 20, as the 14 child of Wieslaw Skowronek. 15 (c) \$33,333.33 to Victor Skowronek, as the minor child 16 of Wieslaw Skowronek, to be placed in the quardianship account 17 established for Victor Skowronek. (d) \$33,333.33 to Hubert Skowronek, as the minor child 18 of Wieslaw Skowronek, to be placed in the guardianship account 19 20 established for Hubert Skowronek. 21 (2) Amounts paid for attorney's fees and costs, as 22 limited in accordance with s. 768.28, Florida Statutes, shall be payable pro rata from each of the claimants. 23 24 Section 3.
