On page 3, line 1,

insert:

Section 2. Subsection (5) is added to section 112.533,  
Florida Statutes, to read:

112.533 Receipt and processing of complaints.--

(5) The Legislature finds as a matter of public policy  
and fact that it is necessary to provide statewide uniform  
standards and rights for the investigation of complaints  
against law enforcement and correctional officers and the  
interrogation of any such officer during the investigation for  
any reason that could lead to disciplinary action, demotion,  
or dismissal. Therefore, when a law enforcement agency or  
correctional agency has undertaken an investigation as  
provided in this section, it shall be the exclusive procedure  
for investigation of a complaint against such an officer for a  
finding of whether or not to proceed with disciplinary action

2 be undertaken by a non-agency reviewing authority for purposes  
3 of investigation of such a complaint, since the Legislature
