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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. Subsection (6) of section 339.2817, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

339.2817 County Incentive Grant Program. --

(6) A municipality may apply to the county in which the municipality is located for consideration by the county for funding under this section of any project or project phase of a transportation facility which is located on the State Highway System or which is demonstrated to relieve congestion on the State Highway System. The county must evaluate all municipal applications as provided in subsection (3). If the proposed project is determined by the county to meet the criteria in subsection (3), the county shall send the application to the department on behalf of the municipality. If the proposed project is then approved by the department, the county may retain project oversight authority and responsibility or delegate such oversight authority and responsibility to the applicant. If a municipality's proposed project is rejected by the county for funding under this section, or if the county's proposed project adversely affects

a municipality within the county, the municipality may request mediation to resolve any concerns of the municipality and the county. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law. HOUSE SUMMARY Revises provisions relating to application by a municipality for grants from the County Incentive Grant Program within the Department of Transportation. Requires the county to determine the application's compliance with certain criteria prior to submitting it to the department. Provides that, upon approval by the department, the county may retain oversight authority and responsibility for the project or delegate that authority and responsibility to the applicant.
