Any unencumbered funds remaining 13 undisbursed on or at the close of the fiscal year on June 30, from the Quick-Response Training Program, from brownfield 14 15 redevelopment bonus refunds, and from unencumbered, 16 undisbursed funds appropriated in the General Appropriations Act for cleanup of state-owned lands shall be used for grants 17 to fund expenses relating to the assessment and remediation of 18 19 brownfield sites within areas designated pursuant to s. 20 376.80, Florida Statutes, for those jurisdictions that have United States Environmental Protection Agency brownfield pilot 21 22 projects designated prior to July 1, 1997. Grants shall be distributed to eligible pilot projects under this section on a 23 pro rata basis in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 per pilot 24 25 project. 26 Section 2.
