In 16 addition to curriculum design and content, each plan must 17 address the following: 18 (a) An implementation strategy and timeline. 19 (b) A foreign language professional development 20 program for instructional personnel. 21 (c) An estimated program budget. 22 23 Each school district must submit its plan to the Commissioner 24 of Education by June 30, 2004. 25 (2) The Department of Education shall provide 26 technical assistance to the school districts upon request. 27 (3) The commissioner shall prepare a summary of school district plans for submission to the Governor, the President 28 29 of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives 30 by January 1, 2005.
