If the county is not participating in such a program 21 22 or if a municipality within the county maintains a radio 23 communication program independent of the county, funds collected within the territorial jurisdiction of the 24 25 municipality may must be used to fund local law enforcement automation and must be distributed to the municipality or 26 27 special improvement district in which the violation occurred or to the county if the violation occurred within the 28 29 unincorporated area of the county.
