Section 2. Effective July 1, 2003, paragraph (a) of subsection (29) of section 121.021, Florida Statutes, as amended by this act, is amended to read:

121.021 Definitions.--The following words and phrases as used in this chapter have the respective meanings set forth unless a different meaning is plainly required by the context:

- (29) "Normal retirement date" means the first day of any month following the date a member attains one of the following statuses:
  - (a) If a Regular Class member, the member:
- 1. Completes 6 or more years of creditable service and attains age 62; or
- 2. Completes 30 25 years of creditable service, regardless of age, which may include a maximum of 4 years of military service credit as long as such credit is not claimed under any other system, and attains age 50.

"Normal retirement age" is attained on the "normal retirement date."

Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision, a person who retires during the period of July 1, 2002, through June 30, 2003, upon attaining his or her normal retirement age, but who does not meet the definition of "normal retirement age" that was in effect on June 30, 2002, is not eligible to participate in the Deferred Retirement Option Program established in section 121.091(13), Florida Statutes.

Section 4. Except as otherwise provided herein, this act shall take effect July 1, 2002.

## LEGISLATIVE SUMMARY

Authorizes normal retirement for members of the Regular Class under the Florida Retirement System after 25 years of service and attainment of age 50. The authorization is for a 1-year period beginning July 1, 2002, and ending June 30, 2003. Prohibits participation in the Deferred Retirement Option Program by persons who qualify for normal retirement during the 1-year period who would not have qualified under the definition of "normal retirement date" as it existed on June 30, 2002.
