In developing and 26 administering the program, the corporation may: 27 (i) Establish a program to provide permanent loans for 28 residents of a mobile home park established under chapter 723 29 at the time that residents elect to purchase the mobile home 30 park from the park owner and become owners of the property 31 either in fee simple or in a cooperative ownership. 1
