Section 15. Section 470.0357, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

470.0357 DNA analysis of human remains.--A licensee or registrant under this chapter in charge of the final disposition of dead human remains shall, before final disposition of the human remains, take two biological specimens from the deceased for DNA analysis as defined in s. 760.40. One DNA sample shall be retained by the licensee or registrant and one DNA sample shall be given to the next of kin or legal representative of the deceased.
