21	(1) It is the intent of the Legislature to promote						
22	effective and cost-efficient noninstructional services.						
23	Accordingly, the Legislature believes that this intent is best						
24	served when school districts analyze the provision of						
25	facilities operations and maintenance to determine the optimal						
26	balance between the costs associated with providing such						
27	services and the quality of the services provided. When this						
28	intent is best served by private-sector providers, school						
29	districts may contract with such providers for these services.						
30	Any costs savings that result shall be redirected to						
31	educational services for students. For purposes of this						
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section, educational services may include any or all of the costs savings to be paid as a bonus to classroom teachers. It is the further intent of the Legislature that this be an ongoing, periodic activity of all school districts.

- (2) Each district school board shall conduct a written analysis of the cost and of the level and quality of services associated with facilities operations and maintenance and shall issue request for proposals or solicitation of bids for the provision of these services. The required analysis and the request for proposals or solicitation of bids shall be in a form consistent with that provided to the Department of Education by the Florida School Boards Association and Florida Taxwatch.
- (3) School districts may form consortia for the purpose of conducting an analysis and request for proposals or solicitation of bids unless otherwise prohibited by law.
- (4) Within 30 days after the conclusion of the bid process, the district school board, at a regularly scheduled board meeting, shall disclose and discuss the responses to the request for proposals or solicitation of bids, including a written comparison to the analysis required in subsection (2) and a written report of the results of the bid process.
- (5) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any cost savings realized by a school district through the provision of contracted facilities operations and maintenance services pursuant to this section shall be retained by the school district and shall be used for the improvement of educational services for students. For purposes of this section, educational services may include any or all of the cost savings to be paid as a bonus to classroom teachers.
 - (6) The Department of Education shall provide

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technical	assistance	to	school	districts	for	the	purpose	of	
implementing this section.									

- (7) Annually, as of January 1, each district school board shall report the results of the implementation of this section to the Commissioner of Education. The report shall include:
- (a) New private contracts for facilities operations and maintenance.
- (b) The anticipated cost savings associated with the new contract.
- The district school board authorized use of the anticipated savings.
- (d) Actual cost savings and use of savings of prior-year private contracts.
- (e) A description of each instance in which a request for proposals or solicitation of bids process did not result in a contract, including a comparison of the school district cost obtained from the cost analysis to the cost proposed by each bidder, the school district's reasoning for not entering into a contract and where the school district's action or inaction is documented in public records.
- (8) Annually, by February 1, the Commissioner of Education shall issue to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a report that consolidates information submitted by the school districts to the commissioner pursuant to subsection (7).
