An act relating to the Department of Business
and Professional Regulation; amending s.
550.334, F.S.; revising criteria for
substitutions in quarter horse races; providing
an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (7) of section
550.334, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

550.334 Quarter horse racing; substitutions.--
(7)(a) Any quarter horse racing permitholder operating
under a valid permit issued before January 1, 2002, by the
division which has not been relocated after December 31, 2001,
to a county other than the county that appears on the original
permit application is authorized to substitute other races of
other breeds of horses which are, respectively, registered
with the American Paint Horse Association, Appaloosa Horse
Club, Arabian Horse Registry of America, Jockey Club, Palomino
Horse Breeders of America, or United States Trotting
Association, for no more than 50 percent of the quarter horse
races daily.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN
COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
SB 1670

Provides that any quarter horse permit holder operating under a valid permit issued before January 1, 2002, which has not relocated after December 31, 2001, to a county other than the county that appears on the original permit application is authorized to substitute other races of other breeds of horses. The act takes effect upon becoming a law.
