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Section 34. Subsection (5) of section 601.155, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

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601.155 Equalizing excise tax; credit; exemption.--

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(5) ~~All Products made subject to the taxable~~

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~~privileges under this section, which products are produced in whole or in part from citrus fruit on which an equivalent tax is levied pursuant to s. 601.15 grown within the United~~

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~~States, are exempt from the tax imposed by this section to the extent that the products are derived from oranges or~~

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~~grapefruit grown within the United States. In the case of products made in part from citrus fruit exempt from the tax~~

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~~imposed by this section grown within the United States, it shall be the burden of the persons liable for the excise tax~~

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to show the Department of Citrus, through competent evidence, proof of that part which is not subject to a taxable
