fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund. In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State Constitution, the Emergency Response Trust Fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2006.
