- (2) It is unlawful for any person to knowingly falsify, alter, destroy, deface, overwrite, remove, or discard records of the Department of Children and Family Services or its contract provider relating to child abuse investigations, or investigations of abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult.
- (a) Except as provided in paragraphs (b) and (c), any person who violates this subsection commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
- (b) In any case in which the victim of the alleged child abuse suffers great bodily harm or dies after the initial report of child abuse to the Department of Children and Family Services is made, any person who violates this subsection at a point in time after the child sustains great bodily harm or dies commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
- (c) In any case in which the victim of the alleged abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult suffers great bodily harm or dies after the initial report of abuse of an elderly person or disabled adult to the Department of Children and Family Services is made, any person who violates this subsection at a point in time after the victim sustains great bodily harm or dies commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.
  - (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 948.01, a

court may not suspend, defer, or withhold adjudication of guilt or imposition of sentence for any violation of this section.

(4) This section does not apply to the disposal of records or the archiving of records of the Department of Children and Family Services as otherwise provided by law. In addition, this section does not prohibit any person from correcting or updating records, so long as the original record entries are not altered or destroyed.
