A bill to be entitled An act relating to Indian reservations; amending s. 285.16, F.S.; providing that the state shall not have jurisdiction over crimes by one Miccosukee committed against the person or property of another Miccosukee within the reservations of the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 285.16, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

285.16 Civil and criminal jurisdiction; Indian reservation; exception. --

- (1) The State of Florida hereby assumes jurisdiction over criminal offenses committed by or against Indians or other persons within Indian reservations and over civil causes of actions between Indians or other persons or to which Indians or other persons are parties rising within Indian reservations.
- (2) The civil and criminal laws of Florida shall obtain on all Indian reservations in this state and shall be enforced in the same manner as elsewhere throughout the state.
- (3) Upon consent of the Secretary of Interior to this retrocession of jurisdiction, subsections (1) and (2) of this section shall not apply to criminal offenses committed by an enrolled member of the Miccosukee Tribe of Indians of Florida, or a person eligible for such enrollment, against the person or property of any other such enrolled member or person
