A bill to be entitled

An act relating to parking permits for the disabled; amending s. 320.0848, F.S.; revising provisions prescribing the appearance of such parking permits, to require a photograph of the applicant; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section 320.0848, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

320.0848 Persons who have disabilities; issuance of disabled parking permits; temporary permits; permits for certain providers of transportation services to persons who have disabilities.--

- (2) DISABLED PARKING PERMIT; PERSONS WITH LONG-TERM MOBILITY PROBLEMS.--
- (a) The disabled parking permit is a placard that can be placed in a motor vehicle so as to be visible from the front and rear of the vehicle. Each side of the placard must have the international symbol of accessibility in a contrasting color in the center so as to be visible. One side of the placard must display the applicant's driver's license number or state identification card number and a photograph taken within 4 years prior to the date of the application for the placard along with a warning that the applicant must have such identification at all times while using the parking permit. A validation sticker must also be issued with each disabled parking permit, showing the month and year of expiration on each side of the placard. Validation stickers must be of the size specified by the Department of Highway

Safety and Motor Vehicles and must be affixed to the disabled parking permits. The disabled parking permits must use the same colors as license plate validations. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002. SENATE SUMMARY Revises a provision relating to parking permits for disabled persons having long-term mobility problems. Deletes a warning requirement and requires that the permit placard display a photograph of the applicant taken within 4 years prior to the date of application for the placard.
