HOUSE SUMMARY Revises a provision of law with respect to liability for the sale of alcoholic beverages to a person who is not of lawful drinking age to eliminate the willful and unlawful sale of such beverages and to provide for the failure to request and check certain forms of identification to confirm the age of the person to whom the beverages are sold.
