The list may be developed from existing sources of information, including, without limitation, the United States 27 28 Food and Drug Administration, the Centers for Disease Control 29 and Prevention, the Occupational Safety and Health 30 Administration, and the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.
