A bill to be entitled
An act relating to motor vehicles; repealing s.
29(19), ch. 2001-196, Laws of Florida, relating
to a provision of law making it a deceptive and
unfair trade practice for a motor vehicle
dealer to add certain additional charges for
pre-delivery services; providing for
retroactive application; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (19) of section 29 of chapter
2001-196, Laws of Florida, is repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law and shall apply retroactively to any motor vehicle sold on
or after October 1, 2001.

HOUSE SUMMARY

Repeals a provision of law which makes it a deceptive and
unfair trade practice for a motor vehicle dealer to add
an additional charge for pre-delivery services other than
those shown on a conspicuous label attached to the window
