insert:

Section 9. Subsection (2) of section 101.031, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

101.031 Instructions for electors.--

(2) The supervisor of elections in each county shall have posted at each polling place in the county the Voter's Bill of Rights and Responsibilities in the following form:

VOTER'S BILL OF RIGHTS

Each registered voter in this state has the right to:

1. Vote and have his or her vote accurately counted.
2. Cast a vote if he or she is in line at the official closing of ~~when~~ the polls in that county ~~are closing~~.
3. Ask for and receive assistance in voting.
4. Receive up to two replacement ballots if he or she

1 makes a mistake prior to the ballot being cast.

2 5. An explanation if his or her registration is in
3 question.

4 6. If his or her registration is in question, cast a
5 provisional ballot.

6 7. Prove his or her identity by signing an affidavit
7 if election officials doubt the voter's identity.

8 8. Written instructions to use when voting, and, upon
9 request, oral instructions in voting from elections officers.

10 9. Vote free from coercion or intimidation by
11 elections officers or any other person.

12 10. Vote on a voting system that is in working
13 condition and that will allow votes to be accurately cast.

15 VOTER RESPONSIBILITIES

17 Each registered voter in this state should ~~has the~~
18 ~~responsibility to:~~

19 1. Familiarize himself or herself with the ~~Study and~~
20 ~~know~~ candidates and issues.

21 2. Maintain with the office of the supervisor of
22 elections a ~~Keep his or her voter address~~ current address.

23 3. Know the location of his or her polling place
24 ~~precinct~~ and its hours of operation.

25 4. Bring proper identification to the polling station.

26 5. Familiarize himself or herself with the operation
27 of the ~~Know how to operate~~ voting equipment in his or her
28 precinct ~~properly~~.

29 6. Treat precinct workers with courtesy.

30 7. Respect the privacy of other voters.

31 8. Report any problems or violations of election laws

1 to the supervisor of elections law.

2 9. Ask questions, if needed ~~when confused~~.

3 10. Make sure that ~~check~~ his or her completed ballot
4 is correct before leaving the polling station ~~for accuracy~~.

6 NOTE TO VOTER: Failure to perform any of these
7 responsibilities does not prohibit a voter from voting.
