An act relating to trust funds; terminating and re-creating the Privately Operated Institutions Inmate Welfare Trust Fund within the Department of Corrections without modification; carrying forward current balances and continuing current sources and uses thereof; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of the Privately Operated Institutions Inmate Welfare Trust Fund within the Department of Corrections, which is otherwise scheduled to be terminated pursuant to constitutional mandate,

WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the trust fund before its scheduled termination date and has found that it continues to meet an important public purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public policy concerning the trust fund sets adequate parameters for its use, NOW, THEREFORE,

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. (1) The Privately Operated Institutions Inmate Welfare Trust Fund within the Department of Corrections, FLAIR number 70-2-623, which is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of the State Constitution on July 1, 2006, unless terminated sooner by law, is terminated on November 4, 2004, and re-created.

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(2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued. Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 2004. HOUSE SUMMARY Terminates and re-creates the Privately Operated Institutions Inmate Welfare Trust Fund within the Department of Corrections in order to synchronize its review cycle with other trust funds of the department.
